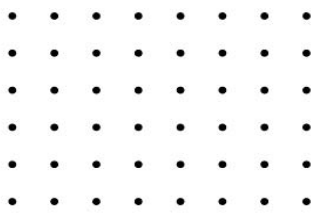


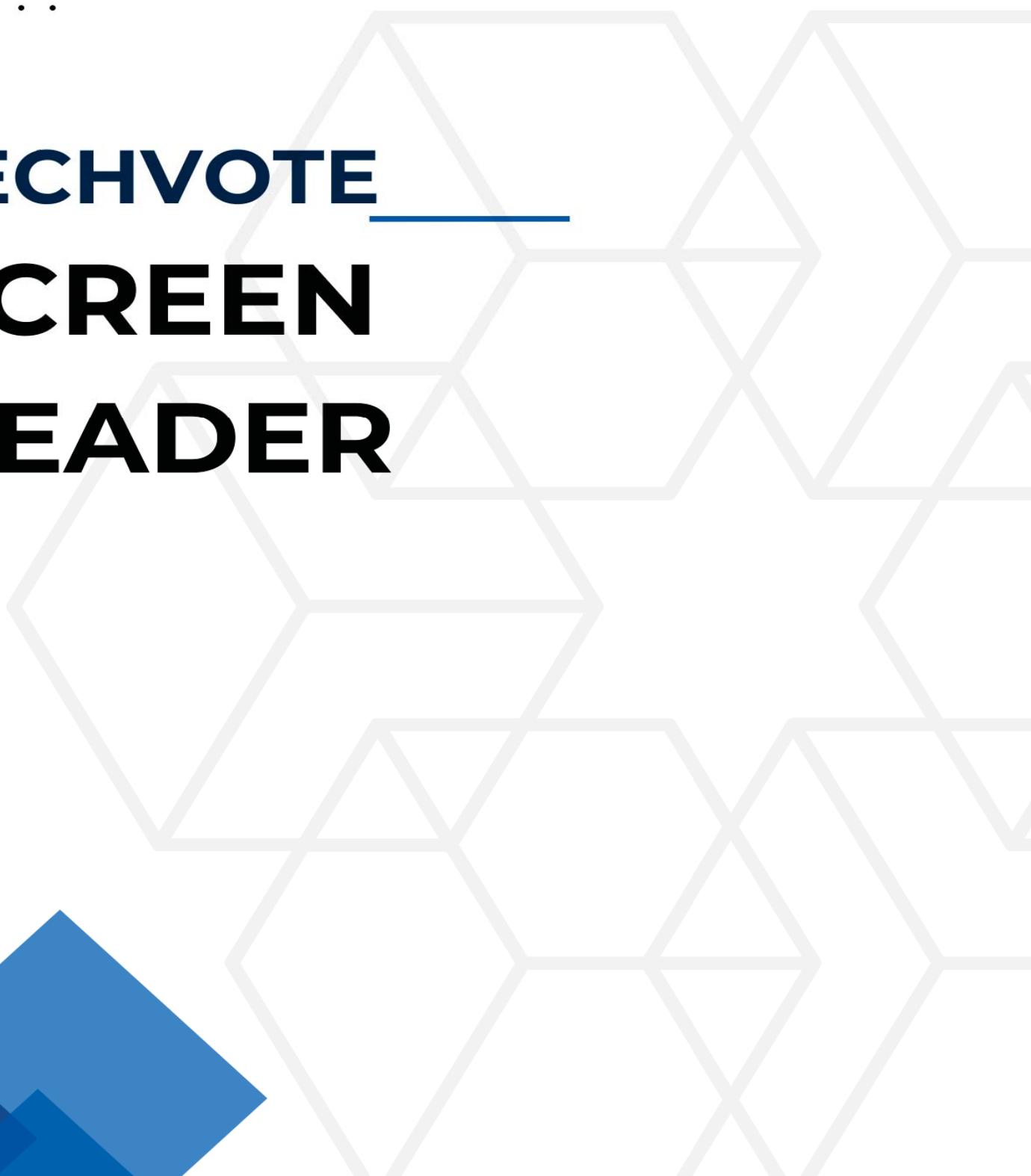

The website will be accessible to people with disabilities using Assistive Technologies, such as screen readers.

The screen reader is a software program that allows blind or visually impaired people to read text displayed on a computer screen by using a speech synthesizer or braille display. Operating systems, applications, and the user interact with each other through screen readers.

Narrator is inbuilt system software which is readily available with Microsoft windows operating system. There is no need to download the application externally. ### How to Start & Stop narrator:

- Press the Windows logo key + Ctrl + Enter together to start Narrator. Press these keys again to stop Narrator. (On older versions of Windows, the command was the Windows logo key + Enter.) On many keyboards, the Windows logo key is located on the bottom row of keys, to the left or right of the Alt key.
- Press the Windows logo key + Ctrl + N to open Narrator settings, and then turn on the toggle under Use Narrator.
